Laurie Hardy (Marion Crain) is overjoyed to be on stage again, especially working once more with Thom. Despite art imitating life somewhat here (aging actors always looking for the next show) this is yet another challenging role. Some past roles include Maria Callas (Master Class) M'Lynn (Steel

Magnolias) Clairee (Steel Magnolias) Dotty Otley (Noises Off!) Mrs. Peachum (Threepenny Opera) Ethel Thayer (On Golden Pond)...are you seeing the pattern here? Before the enforced hiatus, Laurie had been performing on area stages almost continuously for 15ish years. When not rehearsing, performing and/or studying lines she supports her husband's barbershop chorus habit, and sometimes pretends to be a responsible adult. Thom was born in Boston, MA and spent a good portion of his 20's as an actor in that city. After a 34 year theatrical sabbatical to attend to family and career, he returned to theatre in 2018 at

Somerset Valley Players appearing as John in Calendar Girls, David in Rehearsal for Murder, Mike in Legally Grey (opposite the amazing Laurie Hardy), and most recently as Judge Gaffney in Harvey. He has also been seen as Efram in The Nance (Circle Players), and Tom in Dinner with Friends (Center Players). Thom thanks his wonderful director Judi Parrish for the opportunity; Jennifer Boutros and our terrific crew for their hard work and professionalism. And a very special thank you to Laurie for being the greatest stage wife, and, once again, putting up with his nonsense. Thom is the very proud father of Rachel and Emily. And he shares the remainder of his time with the beautiful and brilliant Mary Jane Carroll, who has earned a special place in Heaven for that duty.

Judi Parrish (Director/Lighting Design) With over 50 years in community theatre, Judi has credits as a director, musical director, producer, stage manager, set designer, lighting designer, sound designer and actress. She has 2 NJACT Perry awards with MPO, one for acting (Superintendent in The Drowsy Chaperone), and one for scenic design (NOISES OFF!) Other directing credits include: Steel Magnolias, The Miracle Worker, Agnes of God, The Musical of Musicals: The Musical, A Streetcar Named Desire, Master Class, The Glass Menagerie, Proof, and Doubt, A Parable. Her next directing project will be Olive & The Bitter Herbs for Langhorne Players in April. When not doing theatre she spends her time with her cat, Filbert, going for long canal walks, and planning trips with her son and son-in-law!

John Maurer (Producer/Marketing/Set Design) John founded MPO with his wife, Diana, and his brother, Dan, in 2004. John has directed over 22 plays and musicals, including Around the World in 80 Days (Perry Award for Outstanding Production of a Play) and City of Angels. He is an accomplished set designer, costume designer, make-up artist, and prop master. He holds 25 of the company's 67 NJACT Perry Award nominations, having won seven times. John started in theater at the age of 10 and ever since then has been an actor, magician, clown, juggler, balloon sculptor, stilt-walker, and mime and has specialized in comedy and improvisational theater. John and Diana are internationally produced playwrights, having written three interactive plays that have been produced in England, New Zealand, and US.

Diana Gilman Maurer (Producer) Diana is a mom, actress, producer, and director. She founded Maurer Productions OnStage with her husband, John, and brother-in-law, Dan. MPO has won numerous Kelsey & Perry Awards, including Outstanding Production of a Musical (AIDA) and Outstanding Production of a Play (Driving Miss Daisy and Around the World in 80 Days). Diana was nominated for Kelsey Awards for directing A Little Murder Never Hurt Anybody and Jake's Women. She was nominated for a Perry Award and won the Kelsey Award for Outstanding Director of a Play (Sleuth) in 2018. Her next project will be directing the children's show Nick Tickle, Fairy Tale Detective for the Kelsey Players this March.

Jennifer Boutros (Stage Manager) Jennifer is beyond thrilled to be back at Kelsey Theater and honored to work with Maurer Productions OnStage for the very first time. After far too long of a hiatus, she returned to the theater in the winter of 2020 and performed in Journey to Broadway (Ensemble), Inherit the Wind (Mrs. Blair), and The Sound of Music (Nun). Eager to participate behind the scenes as well, Jennifer also served as stage manager for 12 Angry Men, backstage crew for Cabaret, and lighting board operator for Frozen Jr. Jennifer would like to thank MPO, Judi, Laurie, Thom, and the remarkable crew for working to create such an incredible experience, and she looks forward to joining them again—both on stage and behind the scenes.

Jeff Cantor (Master Carpenter) Jeff started his theater work assisting with set construction on a 2003 Pierrot Productions production of Noises Off! at Kelsey Theater and got hooked. In 2006 while helping with a production of You're a Good Man Charlie Brown, Jeff joined the board of directors of Maurer Productions OnStage (MPO) as Master Carpenter. In the ensuing years, he has worked on over fifty productions for MPO as well as various other community theater and school drama groups with over forty-five master carpenter credits and over fifteen set design credits. In addition, Jeff has stage managed four shows including MPO's production of Aida and worked on running crew or as effects coordinator on over a dozen more. His work has been nominated for three Perry Awards in set design (one win for MPO's Noises Off! in (2019) and six other Perry Award nominations for Outstanding Production including three winners: Around the World in 80 Days (2016), Aida (2012), and Driving Miss Daisy (2008); all with Maurer Productions. Jeff would like to thank John Maurer of Maurer Productions OnStage for his mentorship in set design and construction; Marilyn Stoddard and the rest of the drama program staff at West Windsor Plainsboro High School South for their support and dedication to theater; and his wife Michelle for her love, patience, and understanding.




